

## BEANS

**Soybean, Edamame** - 90 days. This 2-3' plant produces lots of pods that yield 2-3 peas each. Rich in protein, calcium and Vit A and B. Cook like peas or boil pods in salt water for a tasty snack. 1-3' bush. Plant 3" apart, row space 24"

**Lima Bean, Henderson's Baby**- 65 days. Prolific heirloom with buttery baby limas. 3-4 beans per pod. From 1885. Steady producer. 18-24" Bush. Plant 6" apart, row space 2-3'.

**Beans, Pencil Pod Yellow Wax** - 54 days. Big yields of 6" straight pods. Meaty and stringless. Bright yellow makes these beans stand out for easy picking. AKA Eastern Butter Wax. 14-21" bush. Place 3" apart, 20" row space.

**Beans, Roma II** -55 days. Great flavor and tender! Long, flat pods with the robust flavor of Roma pole beans on a compact bush. Great fresh, canned, or frozen. Plant 2-4" apart, row space 24"

**Beans, Royal Burgundy - 55 days.** Stringless, 5" dark purple pods turn bright green when cooked. Delicious frozen, canned, or cooked fresh. Plant 4" apart, row space 24"

**Beans, Scarlet Emperor**- 75 days. Beautiful garden vine grows 8-10' with sprays of beautiful scarlet-orange flowers. Heavy crop of 6-8" slender green pods are plump, juicy and sweet. Runner, heat tolerant. Plant 6" apart, row space 36"

**Beans, Yard Long** -73 days. Vigorous vines with slender beans up to 3' long! Very tender at 12". Grown as a pole bean, these love the heat. Cook like green beans or stir-fry. Plant 4-6" apart, 24" row space.
