## SUMMER SQUASH

Summer Squash, Black Beauty hyb -50 days. Early maturing with delicious deep green fruits and creamy white flesh. Productive over long season. Best when harvested young. Freezes well.

Summer Squash, Butter Belly hyb- 45 days. Open bush habit for easy picking of large harvest. Bright yellow, slightly crooked. 4-6" for nutty flavor and firm texture.

Summer Squash, Cocozelle -50-60 days. Beautiful striped Italian heirloom with pleasing, slightly nutty flavor. Compact bush

Summer Squash, Costata Romanesco- 54 days. Exceptional texture. Italian heirloom with tender, grey-green skin with ribbing.

Summer Squash, Dark Green Zucchini - Straight with creamy white interior. Compact bush-type. 50 days.
Summer Squash, Early Crookneck - 53days. Meaty fruits have bright yellow, bumpy skin. Fine texture..
Summer Squash, Gold Rush hyb- 45days. Beautiful yellow squash for smaller gardens.

Summer Squash, Golden Bush Scallop- Yellow *flying saucer* with a ribbed edge. Vigorous bushes with long season. Harvest 4-5"across.

Summer Squash, Sunburst hyb- 52 days. Yellow patty pan with green blossom end. High yields. Pick tiny with blossom attached or teacup size.
Summer Squash, Tender Grey- 42 days. Small-seeded with extended keeping quality and long harvest period. Excellent flavor and texture.
Summer Squash, Tondo Scuro di Piacenza - Rich, darkgreen color 8-ball. Very flavorful. Vigorous plants
Summer Squash, Tomboncino - 60 days. Italian squash can be eaten young or left to grow large and tan for winter squash. Trellis for straight fruits. Heirloom
Summer Squash, White Scallop- 47 days. This 'patty pan' has a very productive bush. Old variety, likely dating the early 1700's. Fine textured meat.

Summer Squash, Zephyr hyb. 54 days. Slender fruits are yellow with green blossom ends. Pick at 4-6"for nutty flavor and firm texture. Some variation in color with temps.
